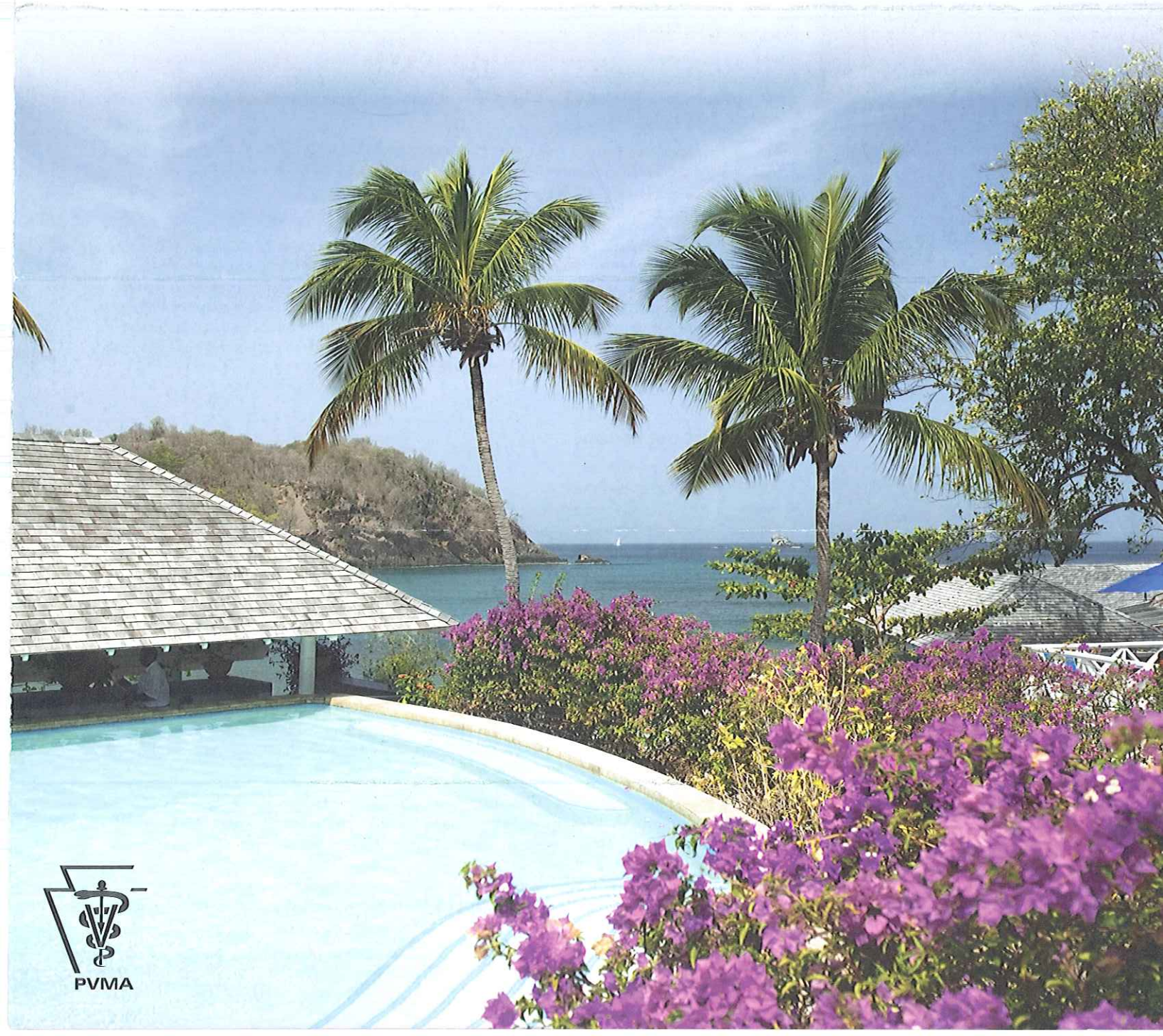

## About the Resort

Located in tropical gardens and overlooking the secluded Bay of Smugglers Cove, the luxurious all-inclusive Smugglers Cove Resort & Spa is bordered by the palm-fringed Caribbean Sea. The resort is a short drive away from Castries, the capital of St. Lucia. Here, laid back luxury and unhurried ambi-

## About the Seminar

A total of 24 seminar hours will be offered, 20 of which are eligible for continuing education credit in Pennsylvania. Karen M. Tobias, DVM, MS, Diplomate ACVS, Department of Small Animal Clinical Sciences, College of Veterinary Medicine, University of Tennessee, will speak on Soft Tissue Surgery: Tips, Tricks, and New Techniques.

Our second speaker is Joe Bartges, DVM, PhD, DACVIM, DACVN, Professor of Medicine and Nutrition, The Acree Endowed Chair of Small Animal Research, C247 Veterinary Teaching Hospital, Department of Small Animal Clinical Sciences, College of Veterinary Medicine, The University of Tennessee, who will speak on Urine Heaven: Medical and Minimally Invasive Management of Urinary Tract Diseases in Dogs and Cats.

The third speaker is Frederick Bart, author of the widely acclaimed book *Middle-Class to Millionaire*. After receiving a medical degree, Bart completed a post-graduate surgical residency under the auspices of the Johns Hopkins Hospital. He spent a decade performing emergency and elective reconstructive surgery before changing the focus of his attention. He delights in transforming persons of average to high income with above average motivation into millionaires. Fred will conduct a lively discussion on how to achieve your financial goals. PVMA provides 20 hours of approved continuing education. Mr. Bart's presentation is not eligible for continuing education credit in Pennsylvania.

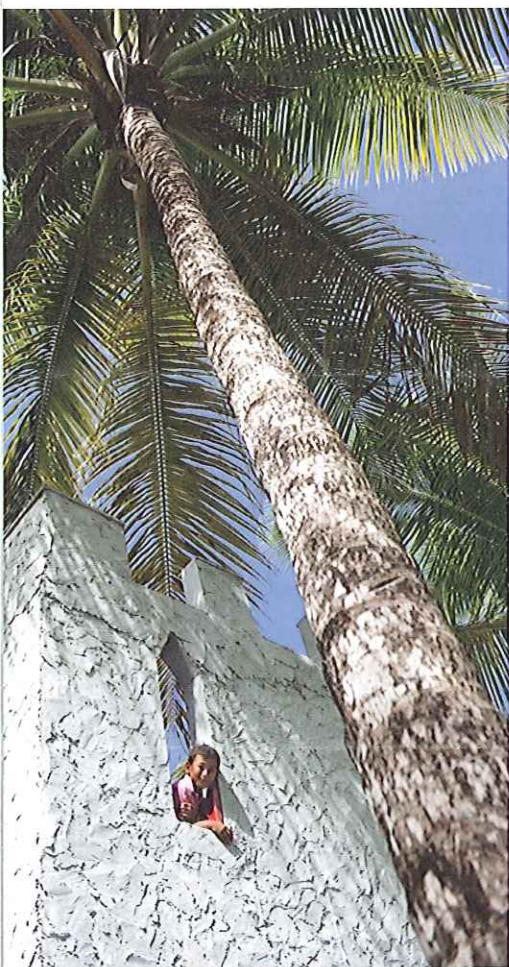
